

Trifold Shutter Card by Claire (Created the Ottaway)

(resized for American A2 cards: 4 ¼" x 5 ½")

Base card – (will be vertical) 5 ½" x 8 ½" (dark 110 lb. cardstock) with LH fold

Inner card – cut 5 ¼" x 8" (white 65 lb. cardstock)

1. Score inner card with short side at top: at 1 ¾" and 3 ½"
2. Turn and score with longer side at top: at 1" on middle panel, at both ends,
3. Then score top to bottom at 2", 4", 6"
4. Turn card back to short end. Cut along each of the 2 score lines, starting at 1" from the top, running to the other 1" from the bottom.
5. Fold middle section opposite the top and bottom sections.
6. Cut and attach DSP for inner card:
 - a. 10 of (a little smaller than each space of 1 ¾" x 2")
 - b. 2 of half that.
 - c. Optional: combine 2 squares for one long section (4" x 1 ¾") in the middle of the middle row. Can put longer sentiment, message, music score, etc.
7. Decorate base card with DSP, putting a white card on back for messages.
8. Attach inner card to base card at right and left sides, top to bottom, from edge to 1", set back from base card ¼".

The dies and DSP I used was STITCHED STOCKING DIES and A STITCHED SEASON paper from Stampin' Up, purchased from www.lisasstampstudio.com.
